JOSEPH 'SWEENEY' EITVYDAS 91 OF NEW BRITAIN DIED WEDNESDAY EVENING AT HOME. HE WAS BORN IN BROOKLYN, NEW YORK AND CAME TO NEW BRITAIN 65 YEARS AGO. HE IS THE WIDOWER OF MARGARET(RIZAUSKAS) EITVYDAS. HE WAS A WORLD WAR 11 NAVY VETERAN. HE WORKED AT THE FORMER SKINNER CHUCK MFG UNTIL HIS RETIREMENT. HE WAS ONE OF THE FOUNDERS OF THE AMBER CLUB AND WAS A LIFETIME MEMBER. HE WAS CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD AND PERMITTEE FOR MANY YEARS OF THE AMBER CLUB AND HE WAS ALSO PAST PRESIDENT. JOSEPH WAS ALSO A MEMBER OF ST ANDREWS CHURCH.
