



## ROBERT J. HUCK

May 12, 1935 - August 23, 2008

Robert J. Huck, 73, of Southington, CT died on Saturday (August 23, 2008) at The Hospital of Central Connecticut . He was born on May 12 (Mother's Day), 1935 in New Britain where he later attended the local schools.

He spent a good deal of his life as an independent long-haul trucker and later was employed by the firm of Tomasso Brothers, Inc., the company from which he retired some eight years ago.
